SUBJECT: Pacific Trust Territories

Since more than a year has passed since the Task Force for the Pacific Trust Territories was established under NSAM No. 145, I would very much appreciate having a report on the progress we have made toward our objectives for the Trust Territories of the Pacific Islands. I am particularly interested in progress on the following areas:

- 1. The situation in the United Nations Trusteeship Council and the Committee of 24.
- 2. Opening up of the Territories to the outside world.
- 3. Educational programs for the Territories.
- 4. Economic development for the Territories.
- 5. The status of Congressional appropriations for the Territories including the various claim bills.
- 6. Status of legislation affecting the Territories, including the adjustment of the status of the Territories under the various domestic and foreign assistance programs.
- 7. Additional steps we should take to prepare the Trust Territories for an eventual plebiscite.
