Subject: Survey Mission - U.S. Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands

Beginning July 3rd a United States Government Survey Mission is scheduled to go to the U. S. Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands to review the major political, economic, and social problems facing the people of that territory.

The Mission, headed by Mr. Anthony M. Solomon, a consultant, will begin its work in Guam and travel throughout the Trust Territory during the following six weeks. From Guam it will proceed to the headquarters of the Trust Territory at Saipan for intensive conferences with the High Commissioner, Mr. M. W. Goding, and his staff, preparatory to visiting the other islands of the territory.
