The United Nations Visiting Mission to the United States administered Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands (PTPI) will visit Washington on January 30 and 31 to hold conferences with various United States Government Agencies preparatory to the departure on February 4, 1954, for the Trust Territory. Governor Mariano will host a luncheon for the group on the 31st. (See Table A, B, and C for Visiting Mission's composition and program.)

The last United Nations Visiting Mission in 1954 was critical of United States administration of the Islands and both the Friendship Council and the more unpredictable Committee of 24 are scheduled to take a close look during 1954 at the United States role in the P.W.I. You will recall that as a result of UNR 114 (Feb 5) the United States Government is itself carefully reviewing plans for the Territory's present and future development. In view of increased scrutiny by the United Nations and our own plans for reviewing and reevaluating our efforts, it is important that the members of the Visiting Mission be as favorably disposed toward the United States as possible. Your greeting thus will appreciably assist to this end.

Discussion:

The United Nations Visiting Mission to the United States administered Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands (TTPI) will visit Washington on January 30 and 31 to hold conferences with various United States Government agencies preparatory to its departure on February 4, 1964, for the Trust Territory. Governor Harriman will host a luncheon for the group on the 31st. (See Tabs A, B, and C for Visiting Mission's composition and program.)

The last United Nations Visiting Mission in 1961 was critical of United States administration of the islands and both the Trusteeship Council and the more unpredictable Committee of 24 are scheduled to take a close look during 1964 at the United States role in the TTPI. You will recall that as a result of NSAM 145 (Tab D) the United States Government is itself carefully reviewing plans for the Territory's present and future development. In view of increased scrutiny by the United Nations and our own plans for reviewing and reevaluating our efforts, it is important that the members of the Visiting Mission be as favorably disposed toward the United States as possible. Your greeting them will appreciably assist to this end.
