As I mentioned to you, I had lunch recently with Senator Bartlett concerning, among other things, the possibility of moving Will Goding from the job of High Commissioner of the Trust Territories of the Pacific. Bartlett stoutly maintains that Goding is doing a good job and he doesn't think he should be changed. If you could convince him that he could be changed to the position, for instance, of Executive Secretary to the Alaska Commission, that's perfectly okay with us. I would suggest that you carry through on this deal and make any arrangements that you see to take care of Goding. From everything I've heard, he should be moved from the Trust Territories and I made this point with the Senator.
