VISIBLE ELECTRONIC GEAR: MAINMAST - 1. UHF/DF 2. VHF DIPOLE 3. Longwire Antenna, LF, VLF 4. Heavy guy to foremast; block and tackle above superstructure possibly used to mount and dismount radomes. SUPERSTRUCTURE: 1. HF/DF LOOP with INJECTION LOOP 2. HF/DF LOOP 3. Canvas covered objects, possibly radomes 4. DON-2 Surface Search/Navigation Radar. 5. Possible CHECK LOCK 6. Unknown - Note vertical handle lower forward edge, possibly indicating demountable cover; possible "ground plane" loop around upper end of cylinder. Device may be UHF or higher frequency DF array, or mount for demountable radomes. FOREMAST: 1. Probable VHF/DF (Canvas covered) 2. VLF Antenna Array.
