LEADER OF PEACE CORP CONTINGENT, ATHOS REVELLE, ARRIVING GUAM BY MATS 9:30 AM THURSDAY, SEPT 23. NINETY-SIX PEACE CORP VOLUNTEERS ARRIVE FRIDAY 5:00 AM BY PAN AMERICAN CHARTERED. THEY WILL BE LARGELY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND AGRICULTURE EXTENSION SPECIALISTS, LATTER BEING LARGELY POULTRY HUSBANDMEN. APPROXIMATELY FIFTY MEN AND FIFTY WOMEN IN GROUP. REVELLE WILL DISCUSS WITH YOU EITHER CENTRAL CORP SITE AT PALAU OR DIVIDED OPERATION BETWEEN PALAU AND YAP. REVELLE IS ASSISTANT TRAINING DIRECTOR FOR PEACE CORP, AND WILL BE ABLE TO READILY PLAN THE TRAINING OPERATION WITH YOUR PEOPLE. REVELLE WILL HAVE RESOURCES FOR PROCUREMENT OF FOODSTUFFS AND ARRANGEMENT WITH MILITARY FOR LOAN OF CAMP GEAR AND OTHER SUPPLIES NEEDED TO BE
