We have reviewed this record and will make it available to you with deletions. These excisions have been made pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(b):

- (6) which permits the withholding of personnel and medical and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy; and,
- (7) which permits the withholding of investigatory records compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such records would:
 - (C) constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.
