Dear Mr. Goding:

We have been reviewing the several resolutions adopted by the Congress of Micronesia and noted that a number call for action by you or by the Secretary of the Interior.

The first fourteen resolutions relate to the organization of the Congress or express appreciation to individuals or groups. I should appreciate having, however, a brief resume of action taken, if any, on the remaining resolutions No. 1-15 through 1-52. Resolution No. 1-18 asks that the two houses of the Congress be renamed and we have on record your views as expressed in your letter of December 2, 1965. We presume they have not changed. We have forwarded copies of Resolution No. 1-19 to the Stevenson family. And Resolutions 1-44 and 1-45 need no comment. A summary of action taken or your comments on the remainder will be greatly appreciated.
