TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL COMPLETED QUESTIONING AND DEBATE ON TTPI JULY 8, MOVED ON TO NEW GUINEA. AMB ANDERSON, ACTING COMMISSIONER NORWOOD, AND YAPESE DELEGATE NUUAN MADE CONCLUDING REMARKS DESIGNED MAINLY TO ROUND OUT US ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RAISED DURING DEBATE. SPECIAL EMPHASIS GIVEN IN THESE STATEMENTS TO IMPROTANCE DEVELOPING MICRONESIAN ECONOMY AND EXPEDITING ECONOMIC SELF-SUFFICIENCY.

BASIS EARLIER RUMORS WE HAD ANTICIPATED DRAFT LIBERIAN RES CONCERNING US RESPONSIBILITY IMPLEMENT WHO REPORT, ALSO POSSIBLE USSR ATTEMPT REBUT OUT CONCLUDING REMARKS. NEITHER MATERIALIZED. BROOKS (LIBERIA) CONCLUDED HIS STATEMENT BY SAYING SHE WOULD BE INTRODUCING RES ON WHO REPORTS LATER.

MCDOWELL (NZ) TOLD MISOFF CORNER (NZ) HAD GONE OVER DRAFT RES WITH BROOKS WHICH CONTAINED FIVE PARAS. HE DID NOT HAVE COPY. HE FELT CORNER HAD PERSUADED HER DROP MORE OBJECTIONABLE PARAS. SOVS WERE OBSERVED WORKING ON HER DURNIG COURSE OF MTG TODAY PRESUMABLY RE RES.
