Dear Mr. Craley:

This will respond to your letter of September 6 concerning the report to the United Nations.

We have been unable to locate even one extra copy of the questionnaire, either in our files, the State Department or USUN. We have a file copy of the 37-page outline which we will Xerox for you if you wish.

We have discussed with State your proposal for revision of the questionnaire. It would not, in any event, be possible to accomplish revision in time for preparation of the forthcoming report since the Trusteeship Council is responsible for the document and any revision of it would have to be approved by that body. Aside from this consideration, there is some question of whether the proposal to revise the document should be brought up at all, since to do so may invite repetition of the criticism within UN made a year or so ago that the report does not include such things as the steps taken to implement the colonialism resolution, and so forth. The State Department wishes to give some further consideration to the suggestion, and we will pass on to you any additional comments we receive from them.
