The Peace Corps provided information to the White House in connection with the President's Pacific trip, and we recently obtained a copy. I enclose it for your information. We were interested in noting, on page 4, that the Peace Corps foresees a five year program with 700 to 850 Volunteers in the Trust Territory. We had not known that anyone's planning had extended to a five-year period, and were recently told that the Peace Corps would not ever have more than 700 PCV's in the Territory. Were you consulted on these matters?
