1. IN THE PRESS

HEADLINE COVERAGE OF YOUR ASIAN TRIP CONTINUES. EVENING STAR TOP NEWS STORY IS "JOHNSON WAXES SENTIMENTAL ON REVISITING NEW ZEALAND." EXTENSIVE NEWS PLAY ALSO GIVEN TO PAGO PAGO VISIT.

SOUTH VIETNAM'S POLITICAL CRISIS RECEIVING TOP BILLING. THE REPORTED RESIGNATION OF THE SEVEN CABINET MEMBERS MADE FRONT PAGE NEWS IN THE STAR, THE WASHINGTON POST, AND THE BALTIMORE SUN.
