Dear Mr. President:

(Senate Resolution No. 15) requests the High Commissioner
to explore the feasibility of using services of the
(Japanese Peace Corps.)

It is recognized that the Japanese Peace Corps may offer
certain kinds of technical assistance not available in
the United States Peace Corps.

However, there are at present approximately 700 United
States Peace Corps Volunteers in Micronesia. We have
had some difficulty in assimilating these young people
and in developing smooth and effective administrative
relationships.

We need a little more time to evaluate the existing
Peace Corps contribution before turning to other coun-
tries for similar help.
