1. Najmuddine Rifai (Deputy Director, Trusteeship Division) has proposed the following schedule for the 35th Session of the Trusteeship Council:

- May 27 - Opening of Session; election of officers
- May 28 - Opening U.S. statements on TTPI
- May 29 - Begin questioning on TTPI
- May 31 - Open Day
- June 3 - Questioning on TTPI and general statements on TTPI
- June 4 - Begin New Guinea consideration
- June 5 - Final statement on TTPI by U.S.

Rifai explained that the above schedule was only tentative and had been drawn up to allow the visiting mission to New Guinea to have additional time to complete its report. He specifically requested U.S. comments on his proposals that the Trusteeship Council begin on May 27 and that the U.S. deliver its opening statement on May 28.

2. USUN has received gentle inquiries about the status of the translations of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights into native languages (referenced airgram). The Mission would like to comment that, if at all possible, it would be desirable for the proof-read documents to
