Dear Governor Daniel:

As heretofore advised by telegram of April 18, I have determined that the damage in various areas of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, adversely affected by Typhoon Jean, is of sufficient severity and magnitude to warrant assistance by the Federal Government to supplement Territorial Government and local efforts.

In order to provide Federal assistance, you are hereby authorized to make an initial allocation of \$2,500,000, plus three per centum for administrative expenses, from funds available for such purposes.
