Dear Mr. Norwood:

This will confirm our discussion concerning the entry of Trust Territory citizens into Guam. You will recall that Mr. Carey raised this subject during hearings on the ceiling bill, and that he seemed clearly to be of the view that there is a problem because the entry burdens are great. We agreed to respond to him further on the subject.

Will you let us know, please, whether this is an area of complaint. Are the Micronesians, perhaps particularly the Saipanese, feeling put upon by the extent of the documentation required? Please tell us, too, what the entry requirements into Guam now are. I believe there was a time when the usual documentation was waived, but about this I am unclear. In certain circumstances waivers can be obtained from the Immigration and Naturalization Service, and should the need exist, we can and will explore this question for you.
