Dear Madam Ambassador:

Your thoughtful letter of July 10 commenting upon the Trusteeship Council presentation and suggesting means of improving it is greatly appreciated. High Commissioner Norwood has recently been in Washington and our people in the Office of Territories took the opportunity to discuss your recommendations with him. Certainly, specific references to Council recommendations can easily be incorporated in the next opening statement.

I understand that in the past some delegations have commented, perhaps in jest, that the opening statements have been so long and so detailed that little was left to discuss during the questioning part of the meetings. We probably over-compensated and erred on the side of too little this year. In any event, your very helpful suggestions have been passed on to all concerned and we hope and expect to be more fully responsive to the needs of the Council next year.
