SUBJECT: MICRONESIAN CONGRESS STATUS COMMISSION

FOLLOWING EXCERPTS ARTICLE FIJI TIMES MARCH: 15 BASED INTERVIEW LAZARUS: SALII.

SENATOR LAZARUS E. SALIII. LEADER OF THE VISITING MOCRONESIAN DELEGATION, HAS ATTACKED AMERICA FOR "NEGLECTING" THE TERRITORY. SENATOR SALIT SAID: "THE UNITED NATIONS AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S. IS THAT THELU.S. WILL DEVELOP THE AREA ECONOMICALLY. POLÍTICALLY, SOCIALLY AND EDUCATIONALLY UNTIL: IT IS READY FOR SELF-GOVERNMENT AND INDEPENDENCE - AFTER 24 YEARS -- SINCE THE INCEPTION OF THE TRUSTEESHIP AGREEMENT -- THE AREA IS NOT ANYWHERE NEAR BEING ECONOMICALLY SUFFICIENT". THERE WAS NO DOUBT THAT AMERICA HAD: NEGLECTED THE TERRITORY EDUCATIONALLY. AMERICA HAD A GOOD RECORD IN THE TERRITORY, SENATOR SALII SAID, AND THE CREATION OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA HAD BEEN A BIG STEP TOWARDS POLITICAL MATURITY. HE ADDED THAT IT HAD BEEN WÖRKED: OUT THAT ROUGHLY \$130 MILLION IN A YEARS TIME WOULD BE NEEDED TO PUT IN THE NECESSARY INFRASTRUCTURE WHICH WOULD PROVIDE THE BASE FOR REAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN THE AREA. "THE TRUST TERRITORY BUDGET HAS INCREASED RAPIDLY FROM \$5,500,000 TEN YEARS AGO TO \$34 MILLION THIS YEAR" SENATOR SALII SAID. "THE CEILING NOW IS \$50 MILLION A YEAR". REFERRING TO MILITARY BASES IN THE AREA, SENATOR SALII SAID THE RESENTMENT OF THE MICRONESIANS WAS NOT ABOUT THE BASES THEMSELVES, BUT AT THE UNLIMITED POWER OF THE U.S. TO TAKE OVER LAND.
