Your letter of 30 April 1969, informing that you have been admitted to the Graduate School in Kearney State College, Nebraska, and asking financial assistance from the United Nations, was referred to me for reply.

The successful completion of your undergraduate work is a commendable achievement, and your intention to pursue your studies at the graduate level deserves every encouragement. Unfortunately, there is no provision for financial assistance from the United Nations.

I may, however, draw your attention to resolutions 557 (VI) and 753 (VIII), by which the General Assembly invited Member States to make available to qualified students from Trust Territories scholarships, fellowships and internships for University study and post-primary and technical education.
