The External Affairs Section and the Defense Section are obviously "out of the ballpark." They amount to nothing less than independence, followed by treaty arrangements with the United States.

Hopefully, these sections represent either (1) extreme negotiating positions and/or (2) handy pieces of paper to take home with them to show "what we tried to get." We will find out Monday morning, or perhaps Sunday afternoon at the football game.
