SUBJ: NEW YORK VISIT OF MICRONESIAN REPRESENTATIVES

REF: STATE 175641 — POL 19 PACT

1. CONGRESS MICROSESIA REPS SILK AND UEKI ACCOMPANIED BY LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL UDUI VISITED NEW YORK OCT. 20. THEY MET WITH GA PRES ANGIE BROOKS, SC PRES CARADON, ACTING TC PRES SHAW (AND AUSTRALIAN DEP ROGERS) AND US REP ATO TC PHILLIPS. AMERICAN LEGAL ADVISER HARROP FREEMAN JOINED THEM IN MEETINGS WITH CARADON AND AUSTRALIANS.

2. MEETING WITH PHILLIPS NOT VERY INFORMATIVE. LEG COUNSEL UDUI ANSWERED MOST QUESTIONS WITH OCCASIONAL ASSENT OR CLARIFICATION BY SILK. THEY REVIEWED HIGHLIGHTS OF WASHINGTON CONVERSATIONS INDICATING NO DEFINITIVE AGREEMENTS REACHED AND SAID THEY EXPECTED TALKS TO CONTINUE IN SAIPAN ON OCCASION FORTHCOMING VISIT SECRETARY WICKLE AND PARTY. RE SPECIFICS OF TALKS, MOCRONESIANS CONFIRMED QUESTION OF CONTROL OVER LAND PRINCIPLA SUBJECT OF DEBATE.

3. ANGIE BROOKS AND CARADON RECEIVED MICRONESIANS FOR APPROXIMATELY TWENTY MINUTES EACH AND ALONE. MISSION ENCOUNTERING DIFFICULTY IN OBTAINING INFORMATION ON THESE MEETINGS.
