- c. Present position - Senator, Congress of Micronesia.
- d. Education - 1937-42, Japanese Elementary School on Saipan Island; 1947-49, elementary and secondary school on Guam, M.I.; 1950-53, high school correspondence courses through U.S.; 1953-54, Sydney University, Australia; 1955-57, correspondence course through Blackstone School of Law; and received High School diploma from Mariana Islands District Board of Education in 1961.
- e. Prior employment - 1949-50, Inouer Constabulary, Saipan Island; 1950-60, Clerk of Courts, Saipan Island; 1960-63, Chief Immigration Officer, Saipan Island; June-July 1964, Acting Assistant District Administrator, Mariana Islands District; and 1963-66, Economic Development Officer, Mariana Islands District.
- f. Political career - 1956-63, Saipan Municipal Legislator, serving as Speaker of that Legislature from 1956-61; Acting Mayor of Saipan in 1963; 1962-63, Associate Judge, Mariana Islands District Court; 1963-64, Mariana Islands District Legislator, serving as President of that Legislature; 1965, delegate to Congress of Micronesia; and 1966-68, Senator to Congress of Micronesia from Mariana Islands District, serving as Chairman of the Senate Committee on Resources and Development during the First Congress, and as Vice-president during the Second Congress. Chosen by Congress of Micronesia Senate to accompany High Commissioner, TTPI, to the United Nations Trusteeship Council in 1969.
- g. Other activities - Subj has served as secretary of Board of Directors of Mariana Islands District Housing Authority; Chairman of Mariana Islands District Legislature Scholarship Committee from 1962-65, and as member from 1965-68; Chairman of Mariana Islands District Utilities Review Board; member of Homestead Review Board; member of Copra Stabilization Board from 1962-63; member of Loan Review Board; member of Land Advisory Board; President of Saipan Credit Union; Co-chairman of Marianas Education Foundation; Vice-president of Saipan Chamber of Commerce; Board of Directors
