US decision based on objections stated over long period of time in Comite over its performance and included <u>inter alia</u> its failure to consult interested parties on proposed actions and resolutions and Comite's infringement of SC prerogatives in UN. USG deferred decision to withdraw in 1968 after consultations with Comite members and sought instead acceptable changes in Comite's performance. Since then, there has been no change in Comite' and past performance was codified for future by Program of Action adopted in 1970 over US objections. LOESCH SENDS
