It was only natural that [REDACTED] write here being an Ex-PCV. This is the second request from the OEO group. (A girl lawyer of the husband/wife team called five or six weeks ago). I feel that Mitchell or someone on his staff or in T.T. should be giving out this kind of data. Again, it is apparent that they are not aware of the realities of the T.T. If anything backfires on this program, we would not want to be in the position of having contributed any information which might be construed in a bad light. Besides, I think the Judiciary Office really should be responsible for providing this info. I provided general info. to the couple, however, [REDACTED] is also interested in other things. As a lawyer, I'm surprised at his gall in asking for what he must know is priveleged data we have prepared re the lawyer controversy.
