RESOLUTION NO. SP-02-71

INTRODUCED BY: THE COUNCIL OF THE WHOLE

A RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO EXPRESSING THE ASPIRATIONS OF THE PEOPLE OF ROTA REGARDING THEIR POLITICAL FUTURE AND RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE DAVID M. KENNEDY, AMBASSADOR-AT-LARGE TO CONVEY THE SAME TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

WHEREAS, being administered by the present administering authority which is the United States of America, the people of Rota have associated the true doctrine of American Democracy, a government which is truly formed for the people, by the people, and of the people; and

WHEREAS, because of these principles, the people of Rota have expressed their keen desire to become permanently affiliated with the United States in any status deemed most appropriate for the people of Rota to take; and

WHEREAS, this official expression to become permanently affiliated with the United States must be considered in such a way that the people of Rota are not satisfied with the present administration as it has ignored and neglected its interest in the development of this island; and the people of Rota have felt that their political destiny is to be with the United States without becoming permanently affiliated with the U.S.; and

WHEREAS, should the people of Rota become ready to elect U.S. Citizens; and it be known that they will elect to become U.S. Citizens;

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT PASSED by the Rota Municipal Council that the political aspirations of the people of Rota are hereby expressed and the honorable Kennedy, Ambassador-at-Large is hereby respectfully requested to convey the same to the President of the United States of America.
