SUBJ: COMITE OF 24-TTPI

1. CHAIRMAN SUBCOMITE II, ARYUBI (AFGHANISTAN), INFORMED MISOFF THAT SUBCOMITE WOULD BE CONSIDERING RESOLUTION OF CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA REQUESTING COMITE OF 24 TO SEND VISITING MISSION TO TTPI ON APRIL 27 AT 10:30. ARYUBI SAID THAT SUBCOMITE HAD REQUESTED HIM TO ASCERTAIN WHETHER US REP WOULD BE PRESENT FOR DISCUSSION OF MICRONESIAN RES. HE ALSO SAID THAT HE DOUBTED SUBCOMITE WOULD DRAFT A LETTER TO BE SENT TO US DEL. SBUCOMITE WOULD REPORT TO COMITE OF 24 STATING ITS VIEW THAT VISITING MISSION SHOULD BE SENT. HE SURMIZED THAT COMITE OF 24 WOULD THEN PROBABLY DISCUSS MATTER AND SEND NOTE TO USUN REQUESTING US VIEWS RE POSSIBILITY COMITE OF 24 VISITING MISSION TO TTPI.

2. MISOFF REPLIED THAT HE WOULD CONVEY MESSAGE TO DEPARTMENT AND SEEK INSTRUCTION. HE POINTED OUT, HOWEVER, THAT, IN LIGHT OF US LEGAL POSITION THAT TTPI CAN ONLY BE DISCUSSED BY SC, US WOULD PROBABLY NOT ATTEND SUBCOMITE MEETING. MISOFF FURTHER POINTED OUT THAT TC REGULARLY SENDS VISITING MISSIONS TO TERRITORY AND THAT THERE REALLY NO NEED FOR COMITE OF 24 SENDING MISSION. ARYUBI SAID HE AWARE OF US POSITION, BUT IN LIGHT OF CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA RES, COMITE OF 24 FELT IT SHOULD BE ABLE TO SEND VISITING MISSION. CONGRESS RES PURELY WISHED VISIT FROM COMITE. MISOFF REMINDED SRYUBI THAT US WAS STILL ADMINISTERING AUTHORITY AND THAT ANY AGREEMENT FOR SENDING VISITING MISSION FROM COMITE WOULD HAVE TO BE REACHED WITH THE ADMINISTERING AUTHORITY.
