AFTER MEETING, Bi TOLD MISOFF THAT THERE HAD BEEN FULL DISCUSSION ON CONGRESS OF MICRONÉSIA RES IN SUBCOMITE. SUBCOMITE WAS MADE AWARE OF FACT US DEL WOULD NOT PARTICIPATE IN DISCUSSION AND RACUF (IRAQ) MADE COMMENT THAT THIS UNFORTUNATE SINCE US HAD IN ITS NOTE OF JANUARY AGREED TO PARTICIPATE ON ITEMS RELATING TO US TERRITORIES. SUBCOMITE DECIDED_PRODUCE INTERIM REPORT FOR COMITE OF 2• BI REPORT WOULD REQUEST CHAIRMAN COMITE OF 24 24 ELICIT VIEWS OF ADMINISTERING POWER (I.E., US) RE FEASIBILITY OF SENDING VISITING MISSION OF COMITE OF 24 TO TTPI. IF RESPONSE OF ADMINISTERING POWER WAS NOT FORTHCOMING, CHAIRMAN OF FULL COMITE WOULD BE REQUESTED TO HOLD DISCUSSIONS WITH PRES OF TO OR PRES OF SC. IN THIS LATTER CONNECTION BI SPECULATED THAT EMPHASIS WOULD BE ON DISCUSSIONS WITH PRES OF TC. REPORT WOULD ALSO RECOMMEND THAT COMITE SEND LETTER OF REPLY TO CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA STATING THAT COMITE WANTS TO ESTABLISH TIES WITH PEOPLE OF DEPEN ENT TERRITORIES. 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STATE THAT COMITE WOULD WELCOME SEEING ANY MICRONESIANS WHO MAY BE VISITING NEW YORK OR WASHINGTON SO THAT THEY COULD APPEAR BEFORE THE COMITE OF 24. INTERIM REPORT EXPECTED TO BE APPROVED TOWARD END OF THIS WEEK. TIMING OF DISCUSSION IN COMITE OF 24 AS YET UNCLEAR, ALTHOUGH UNDERSTAND THAT COMITE WILL HOLD ITS LAST MEETINGS DURING WEEK OF MAY 3 BEFORE IT ADJOINS IN ORDER TO ALLOW ITS AD HOC COMITE TO GO TO AFRICA FOR THREE WEEKS. THEREFORE, IF GUESTION TTPI NOT DISCUSSED NEXT WEEK, IT WILL NOT BE DISCUSSED BEFORE MIDDLE OF JUNE. THAT MEMBERS OF SUBCOMITE II WANTED ACTION TO BE TAKEN ON THIS MATTER AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE AND THAT IT CONCEIVABLE COMITE OF 24 MIGHT START DISCUSSING INTERIM REPORT NEXT WEEK.

3. IN INTERIM USUN HAS RECEIVED TWO NOTES FROM COMITE OF 24 WHICH SENT SEPARATELY. THERE SEEMS TO BE SOME CONFUSION IN MINDS OF COMITE MEMBERS THAT US WILL ALSO PARTICIPATE IN DISCUSSION ON TTPI AND WE SHOULD MAKE QUITE CLEAR THAT WE WILL NOT PARTICIPATE IN DISCUSSION ON TTPI+ RE QUESTION OF VISITING MISSIONS, BELIEVE, IN ADDITION TO FORMAL WRITTEN REPLY, US DEL SHOULD BE ALLOWED TO ALSO TALK ORALLY WITH GHAIRMAN OF COMITE AS WE DID IN PAST WITH NICOL (SIERRA LEONE) AND MESTIRI (TUNISIA).
