REF: USUN 1078 — POL 19 PACTT/UN

1. WATHEN (SECRETARIAT) INFORMED MISOFFI SUBCOMITE II OF COMITE OF 24 WILL BE DISCUSSING INTERIM REPORT ON CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA RES (REFTEL) MONDAY, MAY 3. IT ANTICIPATED INTERIM REPORT WOULD COME BEFORE PLENARY OF COMITE OF 24 WEDNESDAY, MAY 5. ACCORDING WATHEN, THIS SCHEDULING REACHED IN LIGHT OF FACT THAT ON MAY 6 AD HOC SUBCOMITE OF COMITE WOULD BE LEAVING FOR AFRICA FOR THREE WEEK TRIP.

2. WHILE IT POSSIBLE COMITE COULD REACH A DECISION ON CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA RES, IT CONCEIVABLE THAT, UNLESS LETTER ALREADY PREPARED, US DELI WOULD NOT RECEIVE FRUITS OF DELIBERATION UNTIL AFTER AD HOC SUBCOMITE CAME BACK FROM AFRICA. IN ANY EVENT, IF LETTER SENT DURING TRIP TO AFRICA, CHAIRMAN COMITE OF 24 WOULD ALSO BE ON TRIP AND ANY US RESPONSE WOULD PROBABLY NOT HAVE TO BE MADE UNTIL HE RETURNED AT END OF MAY OR EARLY JUNE.
