SUBJ: COMITE OF 24 - TTPI

FOLLOWING IS TEXT OF REPORT ADOPTED BY SUBCOMITE II OF COMITE OF 24 ON CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA RES:

1. AT ITS 784TH MEETING, ON 25 MARCH 1971, SPECIAL COMMITTEE, BY APPROVING FIFTY-EIGHTH REPORT OF WORKING GROUP (A/AC.109/L.687), DECIDED TO MAINTAIN SUB-COMMITTEE II AND REFERRED TO IT, AMONG OTHER TERRITORIES, TRUST TERRITORY OF PACIFIC ISLANDS.

2. AT ITS 126TH MEETING ON 20 APRIL 1971, SUB-COMMITTEE UNANIMOUSLY ELECTED MR. MOHAMMED HAKIM ARYUBI (AFGHANISTAN) AS CHAIRMAN.

3. AT ITS 789TH MEETING, ON 7 APRIL 1971, SPECIAL COMMITTEE ADOPTED 156TH REPORT OF SUB-COMMITTEE ON PETITIONS, (A/AC.109/L.693 AND CORR.1) WHEREBY, (BEGIN UNDERLINE) INTER ALIA, (END UNDERLINE) IT AGREED TO SUB-COMMITTEE'S SUGGESTION THAT CONTENTS OF COMMUNICATION CONTAINED IN DOCUMENT A/AC.109/PET.1160 SHOULD, AS MATTER OF URGENCY, BE TAKEN FULLY INTO ACCOUNT BY SPECIAL COMMITTEE AND IN PARTICULAR BY SUB-COMMITTEE II IN CONNEXION WITH THEIR CONSIDERATION OF RELEVANT ITEM, AS WELL AS BY CHAIRMAN OF SPECIAL COMMITTEE IN DISCHARGE OF TASKS ENTRUSTED TO HIM BY COMMITTEE CONCERNING QUESTION OF SENDING VISITING MISSIONS TO COLONIAL TERRITORIES.

4. SUB-COMMITTEE II CONSIDERED PETITION CONTAINED IN DOCUMENT A/AC.109/PET.1170 AT ITS 127TH AND 128TH MEETINGS, HELD ON 27 APRIL AND 3 MAY 1971 (SEE A/AC.109/SC.3/SR.127 AND 128.) SENATE RES OF FOURTH CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA TRANSMITTED IN DOCUMENT (BEGIN UNDERLINE) INTER ALIA, (END UNDERLINE) INVITED SPECIAL COMMITTEE "TO VISIT TRUST TERRITORY OF PACIFIC ISLANDS TO EXAMINE AND ADVISE UPON PRESENT AND FUTURE STATUS OF SELF-GOVERNMENT FOR TRUST TERRITORY...".

5. SUB-COMMITTEE EXPRESSED HOPE THAT CHAIRMAN OF SPECIAL COMMITTEE IN ACCORDANCE WITH DECISION CONTAINED IN PARAGRAPH 3 ABOVE WOULD AT AN EARLY DATE OBTAIN VIEWS OF ADMINISTERING AUTHORITY ON DISPATCH OF SUCH MISSION TO VISIT TRUST TERRITORY AND CONSIDERED THAT CHAIRMAN OF SPECIAL COMMITTEE SHOULD ALSO HOLD DISCUSSIONS WITH PRESIDENT OF TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL ON SUBJECT.

6. SUB-COMMITTEE ALSO CONSIDERED THAT CLERK OF SENATE SHOULD BE SENT AN INTERIM REPLY TO HIS PETITION STATING THAT SPECIAL COMMITTEE IS IN FAVOUR OF SENDING VISITING MISSION AND IS CONSIDERING WAYS AND MEANS OF DOING SO, IN CONSULTATION WITH ADMINISTERING AUTHORITY AND PRESIDENT OF TRUSTEESHIP CONCIL. CLERK SHOULD ALSO BE INFORMED THAT COMMITTEE WOULD SELCOME APPEARANCE BEFORE IT WHENEVER POSSIBLE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA TO GIVE THEIR VIEWS ON CONDITIONS IN TRUST TERRITORY."
