4. The turn! himself is cagey about his views, but is believed by most to be strongly in favor of Palauan independence, possibly separately from the rest of the territory. He has told some (including the reporting officer) that Palau would accept Commonwealth status "if the land and war claims questions are satisfactorily settled in advance." That particular kind of statement can and should be taken with a truckload of salt.

AS YOU CAN SEE, GENTLEMEN, I AM NOT BOYCOTTING OUR SPECIAL SESSION, IN SPITE OF CERTAIN RUMBLINGS OF MY COLLEAGUES TO THE CONTRARY DURING MY EARLY ABSENCE.

IN MY FIRST REMARKS THIS SESSION, I WANT TO THANK THE PEOPLE OF
