SAIPAN, MAY 27, (MNS)---THE PRESIDENT OF THE TRUST TERRITORY'S NEIGHBORING PACIFIC COUNTRY OF NAURU, HAMMER DEROBURT, WILL BE PASSING THROUGH THE TT NEXT MONTH ON HIS WAY BACK TO NAURU FROM A FAR EAST TRIP.

PRESIDENT DEROBURT WILL ARRIVE ON GUAM JUNE 3 FROM TAIPEI. HE WILL SPEND SEVERAL DAYS ON GUAM, AND WILL THEN FLY THROUGH THE EASTERN DISTRICTS TO MAJURO VIA AIR MICRONESIA ON JUNE 9. HE WILL SPEND FOUR DAYS ON MAJURO BEFORE FLYING TO HIS HOME VIA AIR NAURU ON JUNE 13.

THE NAURUAN PRESIDENT HAS BEEN AN OFFICIAL VISITOR IN THE TRUST TERRITORY BEFORE, BUT THIS TRIP WILL BE UNOFFICIAL AND NO SPECIAL MEETINGS OR EVENTS ARE PLANNED. NAURU IS A MICRONESIAN ISLAND REPUBLIC LOCATED JUST SOUTH OF THE EQUATOR ABOUT 600 MILES SOUTH OF MAJURO.
