1. SENATOR LAZARUA SALII, CHAIRMAN FUTURE POLITICAL STATUS COMMITTEE, HAS REQUESTED FOLLOWING FACILITATIVE ASSISTANCE WITH RESPECT FOLLOWING TRAVEL MEMBERS FUTURE POLITICAL STATUS COMMITTEE, CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA.
2. JAPAN. SENATOR TOSIO NAKAYAMA (TRUKI), SENATOR ISAAC LANWI (MARSHALLS) SENATOR BAILEY OLTOR (PONAPE), REPRESENTATIVE JOHN MANGEFEL (YAP), AND MR STEVE MILLER (PEACE CORPS LAWYER TRAVELING AS SUB-COMMITTEE ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT), WILL DAPART FOR TOKYO ON

OR TWO WEEKS FROM NOW AND PLAN TO STAY IN JAPAN AS LONG AS NECESSARY (PROBABLY NO MORE THAN TWO OR THREE WEEKS) TO DISCUSS INFORMALLY AND UNOFFICIALLY POSSIBLE FUTURE ECONOMIC RELATIONS (AID, TRADE, INVESTMENT) BETWEEN JAPAN AND MICRONESIA UNDER EITHER FREE ASSOCIATION OR INDEPENDENCE. SEN NAKAYAMA IS GROUP CHAIRMAN. ACTUAL DATES OF TRAVEL WILL BE PROVIDED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
