SUBJ: TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL CONSIDERATION TTPJ

1. GENERAL DEBATE STATEMENTS TODAY CONSISTENT WITH LARGELY UNEVENTFUL NATURE OF TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL CONSIDERATION OF TTPJ. SOVIET REP. LED OFF WITH PREDICTABLY CRITICAL STATEMENT OF US ADMINISTRATION KEYED TO THEME THAT THERE HAS BEEN NO SUBSTANTIAL CHANGE IN USG FAILURE MEET ITS CHARTER AND TRUSTEESHIP OBLIGATIONS. STATEMENT, WHICH NOT MATERIALLY MORE CRITICAL THAN THOSE IN RECENT YEARS, AMONG OTHER POINTS ACCUSED USG OF SEEKING TO MAKE MICRONESIA MILITARY AND STRATEGIC APPENDAGE OF US. STATEMENT CLOSED WITH TRADITIONAL LINE THAT FOREIGN MILITARY BASES AND INTERNATIONAL MONOPOLIES DELAYING MICRONESIAN PROGRESS TOWARD "SELF-DETERMINATION AND INDEPENDENCE".
2. AUSTRALIAN REP, DEVOTING MAJOR ATTENTION TO STATUS ISSUE, EXPRESSED VIEW THAT, IN PRACTICAL TERMS, TOW POSITIONS NOT FAR APART. CERTAIN POINTS OF FORM WOULD HAVE TO BE MET BUT MUTUALITY OF INTEREST SO EXTENSIVE THAT RAPID PROGRESS SHOULD BE POSSIBLE. IN USEFUL COMMENT ON SENATOR TUN'S

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SUGGESTION THAT TO MONITOR FUTURE STATUS TALKS, AUSTRALIAN REP SAID HE COULD NOT SEE ADDITIONAL ROLE FOR COUNCIL OR OTHER UN BODY. MOREOVER SUCH PRESENCE WOULD NOT CONTRIBUTE TO INFORMAL ATMOSPHERE WHICH HE FELT BE USEFUL TO PRODUCTIVE DISCUSSIONS. COUNCIL WAS, OF COURSE, ALWAYS READY TO RECEIVE INFORMATION AND SEEK PROVIDE ADVICE.

3. UK REP ALSO DEVOTED SOME ATTENTION TO STATUS. WHILE RESERVING SPECIFIC COMMENTS UNTIL AGREEMENT ACHIEVED, HE SAID THAT HIS DEL. CONTINUED TO BELIEVE OPTIMISM OF LAST YEAR THAT MUTUAL AGREEMENT POSSIBLE NO WAY NULLIFIED BY EVENTS. REGARDING COUNCIL'S ROLE IN TALKS, WHILE NOT MAKING SPECIFIC RECOMMENDATION, HE DID SUGGEST COUNCIL TAKE STEPS TO ENABLE IT PLAY SUITABLE ROLE IF REQUESTED BY BOTH PARTIES.

4. BOTH CHINA AND FRANCE DEALT PRIMARILY WITH OTHER ISSUES, SAYING STATUS ISSUE COMPLEX AND COULD NOT BE RUSHED.

5. CONSIDERATION TTP1 NOW CONCLUDED EXCEPT FOR CLOSING STATEMENTS DUE FRIDAY JUNE 4.
