SUBJ: TTPI: SOLOMON REPORT AND TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL

1. TC PRESIDENT LANE HAS GIVEN US TC REP BENNETT COPY OF LETTER OF MAY 27 FROM F.T. ULUDONG, CHAIRMAN, MICRONESIAN INDEPENDENCE ADVOCATES, -HAWAII ENCLOSING SOLOMON REPORT SPECIAL ISSUE OF YOUNG MICRONESIAN (MARCH 1971). ULUDONG FURNISHED COPIES FOR MEMBERS OF T.C. IN LANE'S OPINION BEST WAY TO HANDLE ULUDONG REQUEST FOR HIM TO DISTRIBUTE COPIES OF ULUDONG LETTER AND ENCLOSURE INFORMALLY TO EACH MEMBER OF T.C., PROVIDING USDEL CONCURS. HE IS PREPARED CIRCULATE AT SAME TIME AN EXPLANATORY NOTE FROM USDEL, IF DESIRED. LANE BELIEVES IF HE FAILS DISTRIBUTE AS ULUDONG REQUESTED LATTER LIKELY TO SUMIT SAME MATERIAL AS COMMUNICATION TO T.C. INSURING EVEN WIDER DISTRIBUTION.

2. BELIEVE PROCEDURE SUGGESTED BY LANE HAS MERIT AND RECOMMEND WE GO ALONG WITH IT. SUGGESTIONS CONCERNING CONTENTS OF NOTE OF EXPLANATION REQUESTED.
