1. TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL (TC) PRESIDENT LANE (UK) BRIEFED US REP, AMB BENNETT, ON HIS JUNE 11 PM MEETING WITH CHAIRMAN, COMITE 24, AMB. NAVA CARRILLO (VENEZUELA) RE: QUESTION OF VISITING MISSIONS. LANE AND NAVA CARRILLO REPORTEDLY REACHED TENTATIVE UNDERSTANDING CONCERNING JOINT TC/COMITE 24 MISSION TO OBSERVE NEW GUINEA HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY ELECTION IN MARCH-APRIL 1972 AS REQUESTED BY AUSTRALIA. LANE THEN SPOKE TO NAVA CARRILLO OF "CONTINGENCY PLANNING" FOR A SPECIAL MISSION TO TTPI AND OF COMMUNICATION FROM COMITE 24 TO TC PRES RELATING TO MICRONESIAN SENATE'S INVITATION TO COMITE 24 TO SEND VISITING MISSION TO MICRONESIA. LANE TOLD NAVA CARRILLO HE HAD READ WITH INTEREST RECORD OF COMITE 24 MEETING WHICH HEARD MICRONESIAN STATUS DELEGATION CO-CHAIRMAN SALII AND SILK, AND HAD NOTED THAT EARLIER INVITATION, WHILE NOT WITHDRAWN, WAS DEFINITELY POSTPONED TO UNSPECIFIED FUTURE DATE, AND MADE CONDITIONAL ON BREAKDOWN IN PENDING US-MICRONESIAN NEGOTIATIONS.
