THE RECOMMENDATION WAS MADE ON THE BASIS OF THE COUNCIL'S DISCUSSION OF A FEBRUARY 19 RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE MARIANAS DISTRICT LEGISLATURE. SAYING THAT THE DISTRICT WOULD SECEDE FROM THE TRUST TERRITORY BY FORCE OF ARMS IF NECESSARY, AND WITH OR WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS. THE RESOLUTION WAS SUPPORTED IN TESTIMONY GIVEN TO THE COUNCIL LAST MONTH IN NEW YORK BY A MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE, DANIEL MUNA.



PALAU JUNE 18 (MNS) -- THE COMPLICATED PROCESS OF INVESTIGATION AND REGISTERING ALL LAND PARCELS IN PALAU DISTRICT HAS BEGUN. LATE LAST MONTH THE KORDR LAND REGISTRATION TEAM COMPLETED ITS INVESTIGATION AND BOUNDARY NEGOTIATIONS ON 21 PARCELS OF LAND IN ILLIL KEREWEL AND NGESECHEWAS ON ARAKABESANG ISLAND. EARLY IN JUNE THEY HELD THEIR FIRST PRELIMINARY INQUIRY UNDER THE LAND COMMISSION ACT.


DEPUTY DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR! HARUO: REMELTIK, USED THE OCCASION OF THIS FIRST LAND HEARING IN HIS DISTRICT TO EXPLAIN TO THE PEOPLE: THE PURPOSE OF THE LAND COMMISSIONS AND REGISTRATION TEAMS. HE EXPLAINED THAT THE LAND COMMISSION ACT "WILL CONVERT THE PRESENT LAND SYSTEMS TO ONE OF ORDERLY WRITTEN REGISTRATION

PAGE FIVE: RUHGSAA4728 UNCLAS AND RECORDING. THIS WILL! NOT AFFECT ANY CUSTOMRY LAND USES OR LAND TENURE PATTERNS. THERE IS PRESENTLY NO OFFICIAL WRITTEN SYSTEMATIC: RECORD OF THE STATUS OF EACH PARCEL OF LAND IN THE PALAUL DISTRICT. HELSAID AND THE ACT WILL! PROVIDE: FOR ONE.

THE DEPUTY DISTAD SAID THE MAJOR INNOVATION OF THE LAND COMMISSION ACT WILL BE THE INTRODUCTION OF THE REGISTRATION OF TITLES. TOGETHER WITH OTHER PROVISIONS OF THE LAW, WILL PROTECT THE INTERESTS OF EVERY LAND OWNER BY PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING HAS BOUNDARIES AND HIS TITLE. IT WILL NOT TAKE AWAY ANY RIGHTS THAT LAND OWNERS AT PRESENT ENJOY, AND IT WILL NOT PLACE NEW BURDENS OF ANY KIND UPON THEM. "THE LAND COMMISSION ACT," REMELIIK SAID. " IS INTENDED FOR THE BENEFIT OF LAND OWNERS AND EVERYONE IN LAND DEALINGS."
