in the Country of Micronesia (Number 401-71-02)

We are preparing to continue the Peace Corps project in the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands.

This group of ten Volunteers will work in Public Works/Law in the Districts of Truk, Yap and the Marshall Islands. The Volunteers have been requested through the Office of the High Commissioner, a representative of the Department of Interior, as the tenth phase of the Peace Corps Program. With the arrival of this group in Micronesia the total number of Volunteers, assigned as follows, will be 303:



This program will be administered directly by the Peace Corps. The estimated cost for a 27 month period is \$110,800.00.

In accordance with the Secretary of State's letter of August 29, 1962 to you, it is requested that you approve implementation of this program and, in so doing, establish the determination that the Peace Corps will not be performing services which could be performed more usefully by other available agencies of the United States Government in the Trust Territory.

A description of the program identifying the specific activities of the Volunteers is attached.
