SUBJECT:

With reference to Val's memo dated August 18, 1971, regarding the new lawyers here is what we suggest.

- 1. That they leave for Saipan from Washington on or about 15 September, with arrival in Saipan on or about the 18th. In Saipan, they will have about a ten day consultation with such luminaries as TT officials, Country Staff, Congress of Micronesia, Chief Justice, Attorney General, Public Defender, etc. in order to get the "big" picture.
- 2. They then travel to their districts on or about October 1st, to get settled in, find housing, consult with local officials and legislature. We may have variations on this theme, e.g. sending a PCV to another district if a legislature is in session in early October.
- 3. On October 15th they join the Fall training group in district and run the course of language training, etc. with the Micro XII group.

In the case of the only Fall PCV slated for the Marshalls, his training can start as soon as he arrives in Majuro from Saipan.

If we can combine all three in a late September briefing in Saipan, it will greatly ease our welcoming task. We realize that if **September** accepts, he may not be so quickly available, but it would be more than valuable to get him in the regular Ponape Fall training program. (My previous memo had suggested a trip direct to Ponape, but if he can get here before October 15th it would, of course, be preferable to program him with the others.
