SUBJECT: Vista Lawyer for Micronesia

DATE: Sept. 21, 1971

At present, the two lawyers, originally programmed for American Samoa/Vista are slated for training. The program information, though, shared by you is confirmed: the program has been cancelled. That area (Am. Samoa) is the responsibility of the Vista office in San Francisco. However, neither of the two lawyers is entering training in that region for placement in that region:

1. [REDACTED] is slated for the Seattle office.
2. [REDACTED] is slated for Dallas training and has been pre-placed or selected for a project in Oklahoma.

The probability of being able to fill such a request for lawyers this fall is nil. Vista now has requests for 172 lawyers and a total of 99 for placement. Summer, (July-August) fills were 75% of that request. These shortfalls, I believe, are true for Vista's other scarce skills as well as lawyers.
