**INTRODUCED BY: HON. MATEO M. MASGA, ROTA**

**A RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO RESPECTFULLY  
MEMORIALIZING AND REQUESTING THE UNITED  
NATIONS TO ASK ANY NATION THAT IS WILLING  
TO REPAIR AND WIDEN THE DOCK AND CHANNEL  
ON ROTA, MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, Rota Island is one of the islands within the Mariana Islands District in the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands; and

WHEREAS, for the past twenty-five (25) years, the people of Rota have made many requests to the administering authority to repair and widen the Rota dock and to widen the Rota Channel, but until now, the channel on Rota is still narrow and the Rota dock is in substantially the same condition; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the condition of the Rota Dock and Channel, the economy of Rota is at a standstill and in order to assist the people of Rota in establishing a stable economy, it is necessary to make needed repairs on the Rota dock and to widen the Rota Channel; and

WHEREAS, over the years, several deaths have occurred in the Rota channel because of its narrow and hazardous condition; and

WHEREAS, since the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands is under the overall jurisdiction of the United Nations, each member nation of the United Nations shares equal responsibility for the development of the Trust Territory;
