[] AFTER READING MY STATEMENT ON HANA TALKS (AS CONVEYED BY MNS NOVEMBER 10), HAS COMMENTED TO ME THAT ABOUT 75 PERCENT OF MICRONESIANS IN ADMINISTRATION WOULD SUPPORT POSITIONS TAKEN BY U.S. DELEGATION AT HANA--INCLUDING MUTUAL CONSENT TERMINATION PROPOSAL. HOWEVER, HE BELIEVES "SOLID MAJORITY" CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA IS FIRMLY WEDDED TO UNILATERAL TERMINATION CONCEPT AND WOULD NOT BUDGE ON THAT ISSUE.
