FREELY ADMITS HE IS HAVING DIFFICULTY GETTING SUPPORT FOR IT FROM MEMBERS OF COALITION, INCLUDING SENATOR NAKAYAMA. WILIANDER NOW ALSO OPENLY STATING THAT, THOUGH COALITION MAY GAIN SEVERAL NEW MEMBERS THIS SESSION, IT MAY ALSO LOSE SOME. HOWEVER, LOSS WOULD BE QUIET IN SENSE THAT SUCH MEMBERS WOULD SIMPLY CEASE TO ATTEND COALITION MEETINGS

OR OTHERWISE SUPPORT COALITION ACTIVITIES. WILIANDER AND ULUDONG HAVE REPEATEDLY TOLD ME THAT HANA TALKS AND OUR VARIOUS STATEMENTS THEREON HAVE BEEN MAJOR CONTRIBUTING FACTOR TO DECLINE OF COALITION. SENATOR NAKAYAMA HAS MADE SIMILAR STATEMENTS TO ME.

PALAU FOR CONGRESSIONAL SESSION. THUS FAR HE HAS NOT TURNED UP AND I HAVE BEEN RECEIVING HINTS FROM CARL HEINE AND OTHERS TO EFFECT GLADWIN WAS ADVISED IN NO UNCERTAIN TERMS HIS PRESENCE NOT DESIRED. HOWEVER, I WOULD NOT RULE OUT HIS TURNING UP LATER IN SESSION IN TIME FOR STATUS DEBATE.
