SUBJECT: TTPI FUTURE PTTPI OLITICAL STATUS

1. DURING PAST WEEK INDEPENDENCE COALITION HAS HAD SEVERAL MEET-INGS WHICH, BY ALL ACCOUNTS, WERE RATHER STORMY. BUT ENDRESULT FINALLY

WAS, EVENING JANUARY 30, ACCEPTANCE BY COALITION MEMBERSHIP OF BASIC NEW POSITION WHICH AMOUNTS TO FREE ASSOCIATION AT ITS OUTER LIMITS. THIS NEW POSITION WILL BE ANNOUNCED IN A FORMAL STATEMENT BY COALITION

PASSED TO ME COPIES OF INTERNAL POSITION PAPER WHICH FORMED BASIS OF COALITION DECISIONS EVENING JANUARY 30. POSITION PAPER, PREPARED BY SENATOR AMARAICH AND FRANCISCO ULUDONG, IS UNDATED MEMORANDUM (WRITTE



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LAST WEEK) TO COALITION MEMBERS OUTLINING POSSIBLE NEW POSITIONS, STRATEGY, AND TACTICS FOR COALITION.

MEMORANDUM ACCEPTED IN TOTO AND IS NOW OFFICIAL POLICY OF COALITION.

3. AT BOTH BEGINNING AND END OF MEMORANDUM IT IS NOTED THAT COALITION HAS BEEN UNABLE "MAKE ANY NOTICEABLE IMPACT IN TERMS ON INCREASING SIZE OF SUPPORT FOR ITS POSITION ON STATUS QUESTION AMONG MEMBERS OF CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA, LEADERSHIP ELITE, AND GRASSROOTS IN

THE TERRITORY." MEMORANDUM THEREFORE ARGUES "COALITION MIGHT BEGIN TO GAIN POPULARITY AND SUPPORT AMONG THE PEOPLE IF IT CHANGES ITS STRATEGY TO PRESENT LESSER HARDLINE WITH RESPECT TO CONGRESS EFFORTS TO RESOLVE STATUS ISSUE, TO BE UP IN FRONT IN FIGHT FOR MORE SELF-

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GOVERNMENT AND TO PROJECT AN IMAGE AND REPUTATION OF DEFENDING AND
PROTECTING INTERESTS OF ORDINARY PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA." HOWEVER,
"CHANGE OF STRATEGY DOES NOT MEAN WE ARE REJECTING INDEPENDENCE AS A
GOAL. THERE ARE, HOWEVER, CONDITIONS TO OUR SUPPORT FOR FREE
ASSOCIATION. FIRST, FREE ASSOCIATION MUST BE FREE AND REFLECT
POSITIONS
OF COALITION WITH RESPECT MANY ISSUES DISCUSSED ABOVE (SUMMARIZED

OF COALITION WITH RESPECT MANY ISSUES DISCUSSED ABOVE (SUMMARIZED BELOW IN THIS TELEGRAM). SECONDLY, STEPS LEADING TO FULL SELF. GOVERNMENT MUST BEGIN WITH THIS SESSION OF CONGRESS. THIRD, IT SHOULD

BE MADE A PART OF TREATY...THAT WITHIN FIVE YEARS AFTER SIGNING OF TREATY THERE WILL BE ANOTHER PLEBISCITE TO DÉCIDE WHETHER PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA WANT INDEPENDENCE OR NOT."

5. NATIONAL SOVEREIGNTY. "MICRONESIA MUST DEMAND FOR AN UNCONDIT

6. RIGHT TO SELF-DETERMINATION. "THERE MUST BE AN UNCONDITIONAL AND OUTRIGHT STATEMENT OF PART OF U.S. THAT MICRONESIA POSSESSES AND CONTINUES TO POSSESS RIGHT TO SELF-DETERMINATION."

7. CONSTITUTION. "OUR CONSTITUTION SHOULD BE SUPREME LAW OF LAND

AND MUST NOT BE REQUIRED TO BE CONSISTENT WITH ANY OTHER SET OF LAWS, COMPACT OR TREATY. IF U.S. INSISTS ON CONSISTENCY ISSUE, WE TOO MUST IN-

SIST U.S. CONSTITUTION BE CONSISTENT WITH COMPACT. WE MUST PROTECT RIGHTS AND LIBERTIES OF OUR PEOPLE IN OUR CONSTITUTION BUT WE MUST NOT BE REQUIRED BY ANY OUTSIDER TO GIVE ANY ASSURANCES TO DO SO.

8. TERMINATION. "MICRONESIA MUST INSIST ON UNILATERAL TERMINATION."

9. EMINENT DOMAIN. "MICRONESIA AGREES TO ALLOW U.S. TO USE CERTAIN LANDS IN MICRONESIA PRIOR TO TERMINATION OF TRUSTEESHIP AGREE.

MENT BUT MUST NOT CONCLUDE ANY ARRANGEMENTS PERTAINING TO LOCATIONS, SIZE AND COSTS OF LEASES. PRESENT RETENTION LANDS MUST BE RETURNED TO PEOPLE BEFORE TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT AND ALL PRESENT LEASED LANDS MUST BE RENEGOTIATED IMMEDIATELY AFTER TERMINATION." INOTE. ON THIS POINT, HAS TOLD ME SEVERAL, TIMES LEASES COULD ACTUALLY BE NEGOTIATED PRIOR TO TERMINATION TRUSTEESHIP AGREEMENT, BUT

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MUST NOT BE SIGNED UNTIL AFTER TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT.)

10. DEFENSE AND MILITARY INTERESTS. "MICRONESIA IS INDEFENSIBLE
BUT IS WILLING TO ALLOW U.S. USE OF CERTAIN LANDS FOR PROTECTION OF

ITS

NATIONAL INTERESTS. HOWEVER, IT WILL HAVE POWER TO DENY USE OF ANY

LANDS

FOR DANGEROUS WEAPONS AND ACTIVITIES."



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11. FOREIGN AFFAIRS. "MICRONESIA MUST HAVE POLER TO CONDUCT ITS OWN NON-MILITARY FOREIGN AFFAIRS BUT WILL CONSULT U.S. IN MATTERS

PURELY MILITARY IN NATURE."

12. FORM OF ASSOCIATION. "MICRONESIA MUST INSIST ON A FREE ASSOCIATION AS PROPOSED BY CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA" (NOTE. THIS REFERS

PRIMARILY TO TERMINATION ISSUE.

13. IN CONCLUDING SECTION OF MEMORANDUM, IT IS ALSO NOTED THAT "MICRONESIA MUST WORK TOWARD IMMEDIATE SELF-GOVERNMENT SO THAT WHEN TERMINATION (OF TRUSTEESHIP) COMES, MICRONESIA WILL BE PREPARED TO ASSUME FULL SELF-GOVERNMENT." IT IS THEN STATED CONGRESS MUST, TO THAT

END, SUPPORT LEGISLATION ALONG FOLLOWING LINES: \*1. ELECTION OF DISTADS

AND THEIR DEPUTIES. 2. ADVISE AND CONSENT BY CONGRESS OF HIGH

SENIOR STAFF MEMBERS AND HIGH COURT JUSTICES. 3. APPROPRIATION OF FEDERAL GRANT. 4. REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION BY CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA OF

ALL TREATIES AND AGREEMENTS MADE IN WASHINGTON AFFECTING MICRONESIA.

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14. COMMENT. ABOVE IS, OF COURSE, OPTIMUM SHOPPING LIST OF COALITION AND CONTAINS ITEMS WHICH COALITION MEMBERS DO NOT IN FACT EXPECT OBTAIN AGREEMENT ON EITHER FROM U.S. OR EVEN FROM CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA. NEVERTHE LESS, IT DOES IN MANY AREAS BRING COALITION CLOSE TO OFFICIAL FREE ASSOCIATION POSITION.
