

SECSTATE PASS TO DEPT INT/SEC INTERIOR/DASTA/OSN (PAN AM CANCELS CHARTER)

SAIPAN, FEB. 7, (MNS) --- PAN AMERICAN WORLD AIRWAYS HAS CANCELLED PLANS TO BRING A CHARTER FLIGHT TO SAIPAN FROM JAPAN ON FEBRUARY 17. TRUST TERRITORY HIGH COMMISSIONER EDWARD E. JOHNSTON SAID HE WAS INFORMED MONDAY (FEB. 7) BY WARREN A. ELSENER, GUAM MANAGER FOR PAN AM, THAT THE AIRLINE HAS DECIDED TO DIVERT THE CHARTER FLIGHT TO GUAM.

IN A LETTER TO MARIANAS DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR FRANCISCO C. ADA INFORMING HIM OF THE AIRLINE'S DECISION, THE HICOM SAID HE WAS TOLD BY ELSENER THAT THE ACTION WAS TAKEN BECAUSE PAN AM "REFUSES TO SIGN ANY FORM OF INDEMNIOR FICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF THE TRUST TERRITORY OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS."

THE HIGH COMMISSIONER SAID THE GOVERNMENT HAS "MADE EVERY EFFORT TO ADOPT A SET OF RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO CHARTER FLIGHTS INTO THE TRUST TERRITORY BY ANY AIRLINE." ON JANUARY 27, A MEETING WAS HELD ON SAIPAN TO DISCUSS THESE REGULATIONS, AND PAN AM WAS REPRESENTED ALONG WITH THREE OTHER AIRLINES, CONTINENTAL/AIR MICRONESIA, JAPAN AIRLYNES AND AIR PACIFIC. "AT THIS MEETING," SAID THE HIGH COMMISSIONER "THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROPOSED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE TRUST TERRITORY WERE THOROUGHLY DISCUSSED, INCLUDING THE PROPOSED INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT. THE AGCEEMENT SUPSEQUENTLY WAS MODIFIED TO ACCOMMODATE THE SPECIFIC OBJECTIONS CONVEYED...BY MR. ELSENER ON BEHALF OF PAN AMERICAN."

THE HICOM'S LETTER CONTINUED, "IT IS REGRETTABLE THAT

QUIRED BY MANY AIRPORTS IN THE UNITED STATES AND HAVE EXPLORED THOSE FOR CHICAGO, SEATTLE, HOUSTON, LOS ANGELES AND HONOLULU, ALL OF WHICH HAVE AIRPORTS FAR SUPERIOR IN EVERY RESPECT TO KOBLER FIELD, OR ANY AIRFIELD PRESENTLY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE TRUST TERRITORY.

"IT IS SIGNIFICANT THAT NONE OF THE OTHER AIRLINES PRESENT AT THE JANUARY 27 CONFERENCE ON SAIPAN POSED ANY SERIOUS OBJECTION TO SIGNING A HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT," THE HICOM CONTINUED. 

THERE ARE THREE VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL SCHOOLS IN THE TRUST TERRITORY. THEY ARE THE MICRONESIAN OCCUPATIONAL CENTER (MOC) IN PALAU; THE MICCONESIAN MARITIME CENTER FOR THE TRANING OF SEAMEN ON DUBLON ISLAND IN TRUK; AND THE PONAPE AGRICULTURE AND TRADE SCHOOL (PATS) IN PONAPE. 


