SAIPAN, FEB. 10 (MNS) --\*RICARDO R. SANTOS REMAINED IN POLICE CUSTODY THURSDAY (FEB. 10) ON SAIPAN, UNABLE TO POST THE \$1,000 BOND NECESSARY FOR HIS RELEASE. SANTOS WAS ARRESTED WEDNESDAY AND CHARGED WITH ARSON IN CONNECTION WITH THE FIRE THAT DAMAGED THE RESIDENCE OF TRUST TERRITORY HIGH COMMISSIONER EDWARD E. JOHNSTON ON SAIPAN'S CAPITOL HILL LAST NOVEMBER.

MEANWHILE, MARIANAS DISTRICT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS HAVE REVEALED THAT A GOOD DEAL OF ADDITIONAL MATERIAL WAS FOUND IN AND NEAR THE CAVE THAT WAS SAID TO HAVE BEEN USED BY THE SUSPECT. IN ADDITION TO JEWELRY ALLEGEDLY BELONGING TO THE HIGH COMMISSIONER'S FAMILY, POLICE FOUND SOME DYNAMITE, A RIFLE AND OTHER POSSIBLY STOLEN ITEMS, AND A SMALL NUMBER OF MARIJUANA PLANTS, THUS RAISING THE POSSIBLITY THAT SANTOS MAY FACE ADDITIONAL CHARGES.

POLICE ALSO SAID THAT SANTOS' LEGAL RESIDENCE HAS NOW BEEN ESTABLISHED AS CHALAN KANDA DISTRICT ONE ON SAIPAN. EARLIER INFORMATION FROM THE POLICE HAD BEEN THAT THE ARSON SUSPECT LIVED IN TANAPAG. THIS WAS BASED ON THE FACT THAT HIS FAMILY HAS A FARM IN AN AREA NEAR TANAPAG KNOWN AS ASMAHETOK. THIS AREA IS AT THE BASE OF CAPITOL HILL, AND THE CAVE ALLEGEDLY USED BY THE SUSPECT IS NEARBY.

THE 19 YEAR-OLD YOUTH WHO NOW FINDS HIMSELF CHARGED WITH ONE OF THE MOST SERIOUS OF CRIMES IS A TENTH-GRADE STUDENT AT MARIANAS HIGH SCHOOL. IF HE IS FOUND GUILTY OF ARSON, HE COULD BE FINED UP TO \$5,000 OR SENTENCED TO AS MUCH AS TWENTY YEARS IN PRISON, OR BOTH. A TRIAL DATE FOR SANTOS STILL HAS NOT BEEN SET, AND POLICE ARE CONTINUING THEIR INVESTIGATION INTO THE

PLANNING COORDINATION COMMITTEE TO COORDINATE THE TT.WIDE PLAN-NING FUNCTIONS.

THE COMMITTEE WILL BE CHARGED WITH THE RESPONSIBILITY OF PREPARING A DOCUMENTED REPORT TO THE HIGH COMMISSIONER WHICH WILL INCLUDE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR A COMPREHENSIVE TRUST TERRITORY DEVELOPMENT POLICY STATEMENT. IT IS EXPECTED THAT THE COMMITTEE WILL EXPLORE ALL PERTINENT FACTORS RELATED TO PLANNING AND PROGRAMS PRESENTLY UNDERWAY AND CONTEMPLATED, AND MAKE APPROPRIATE RECOMMENDATIONS. ACCORDING TO THE HICOM, THE KEY IMPORTANCE OF THIS COMMITTEE WILL BE ITS COMPREHENSIVENESS, AS COMPARED TO THE SOMEWHAT FRAGMENTED PLANNING APPROACH AT THE PRESENT.

THE HIGH COMMISSIONER HAS NAMED IT PLANNING DIVISION CHIEF PHIL CHAMBERLAIN TO BE CHAIRMAN OF THE NEW COMMITTEE. OTHER MEMBERS, ANDING IN THE DEPARTMENTS THEY WILL REPRESENT, ARE: BILL JACKSON, PUBLIC AFFAIRS: DR. MASAO KUMANGAI, HEALTH SERVICES; DAVID RAMARUI, EDUCATION: WAYNE THIESSEN, TRANSPORTATION AND

SAIPAN, FEB. 10, (MNS)---NEWS FROM WASHINGTON, D.C. HAS REACHED SAIPAN CONCERNING SEVERAL MATTERS THAT ARE OF IMPORTANCE TO MICRONESIA.

IN THE U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, TWO MEASURES THAT COULD HAVE CONSIDERABLE IMPACT ON THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THE TRUST TERRITORY HAVE BEEN APPROVED AND SENT ON TO THE SENATE FOR CONSIDERATION. ONE WOULD AUTHORIZE A FIVE MILLION DOLLAR CEILING FOR THE TT'S ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT LOAN FUND. THE OTHER WOULD AUTHORIZE A THREE-YEAR, THREE MILLION DOLLAR PROGRAM TO DEVELOP THE TUNA FISHING RESOURCES OF THE CENTRAL AND WESTERN PACIFIC. THE BILL IS THE RESULT OF A PROPOSAL BY THE PACIFIC ISLANDS DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, WHICH INCLUDES THE TRUST TERRITORY, GUAM, AMERICAN SAMOA AND HAWAII.

ALSO FROM WASHINGTON, WORD HAS BEEN RECEIVED THAT HEARINGS INTO THE FISCAL YEAR 1973 TRUST TERRITORY BUDGET WILL BEGIN MARCH 15TH IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, WITH SENATE HEARINGS EXPECTED


