SAIPAN, FEB. 17, (MNS)---TRUST TERRITORY HIGH COMMISSIONER EDWARD E. JOHNSTON HAS APPROVED AND SIGNED

INTO LAW SENATE BILLS 130 AND 120 WEDNESDAY, (FEB. 16).

SENATE BILL 130 IS NOW PUBLIC LAW 4C-24 AND AMENDS SECTION

3 OF PUBLIC LAW NUMBER 1-3 TO ENLARGE THE COMMITTEE ON THE
TRUST TERRITORY CODE. THIS BILL ENLARGES THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE

COMMITTEE ON THE TT CODE TO CONSIST OF THE TT ATTORNEY GENERAL
OR HIS DESIGNEE, THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE HIGH COURT OF THE TT
OR HIS DESIGNEE, THE LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL OF THE CONGRESS OF
MICRONESIA OR HIS DESIGNEE, THE CHIEF PUBLIC DEFENDER OR HIS
DESIGNEE, AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE MICRONESIAN LEGAL SERVICES
CORPORATION OR HIS DESIGNEE.

THE COMMITTEE ON THE TT-CODE CONSIDERS AND MAKES RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE ORGANIZATION AND PUBLICATION OF PUBLIC LAWS OF THE TT AND REPORTS SUCH RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE REGULAR SESSIONS OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA. THE COMMITTEE IS AUTHORIZED TO TAKE SUCH ACTION AS MAY BE PRACTICABLE TO PROVIDE FOR INTERIM REVISION, CODIFICATION AND PUBLICATION OF EXISTING PUBLIC LAWS.



IN THE TT TO ASSIST THEM IN PROVIDING TRAINING FOR MICRONE-SIAN STUDENTS IN THE FIELD OF VOCATIONAL AGRICULTURE, IN-CLUDING THE DEVELOPMENT AND STRENGTHENING OF TRAINING STAFF AND CURRICULAR CAPABILITY OF SUCH TRAINING GRANTS WHEN SO AUTHORIZED BY THE DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION. THIS MONEY CAN ALSO BE USED BY SUCH GRANTEES IN ESTABLISHING AND MAINTAINING SCHOLARSHIPS FOR MICRONESIAN STUDENTS STUDYING AGRICULTURE. (WATER PROBLEM IN YAP)

YAP, FEB. 17, (MNS)---ACTING DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR MIKE KILIAN DECLARED EMERGENCY WATER HOURS FOR THE YAP DISTRICT CENTER REGINNING LAST WEEK. 
