SOLUTION DIRECTED AT INVOLVING CONGRESS MICRONESIA IN SELECTION OF HICOMS AND OTHER KEY OFFICIALS, ANOTHER DIRECTED AT CONGRESSIONAL AUTHORITY TO OVER-RIDE HICOM VETOES, AND OTHER MEASURES ARE ALL DIRECTED AT THAT END.

HOWEVER, GIVEN FACT ONLY TENDAYS OF SESSION REMAIN (OF WHICH STATUS DEBATE WILL TAKE UP CONSIDERABEL TIME), IT DOES SEEM LIKELY THAT SOME SIGNIFICANT PENDING LEGISLATION WILL IN FINAL ANALYSIS BE SET ASIDE TO BE TAKEN UP AGAIN AT A SPECIAL SESSION THIS COMING SUMMER.
