## ACTON:

 \%understand that this desire for close association comes 4. "s from the Marianas themiselves and does not represent US initiative to split the TTPI.
2. The US considers that in view Senator Salii's initial statement at Hana, Marianas require no further central authorization to pursue a separate course, particularly in light of repeated Marianas District Legislature resolutions expressing desire for continued close relationship with us. It would still be helpful, however, for the Marianas to make clear through some type of public initiative that they wish toopen separate talks with us.
3. It would strengthen any such request, if the Marianas spokesmen had an authorization from the Marianas District Legislature to engage in discussions with the U.S. delegation concerning the future status of the Marianas.
