MEMORANDUM OF CONVERSATION

Time: 0900 - 8 April - Party Room

Participants: Ambassador Williams
Captain Crowe
Senator Salii
Rep. Silk

1. The purpose was to brief the Micronesian Co-Chairmen on the U.S. defense presentation for this afternoon. Crowe delivered the verbal briefing and essentially just ran through the forthcoming U.S. defense position.
2. The meeting took less than 10 minutes.
3. Salii said the meeting was helpful and that they would be presenting two papers on finance and transition this afternoon.
4. The Micronesians reaction was pleasant and non-committal. However, Salii said the meeting was helpful. A plenary session was set for 1700.
