SAIPAN, APRIL 12 (MNS) ---TRUST TERRITORY HIGH COMMISSIONER EDWARD E. JOHNSTON SIGNED A TOTAL OF 17 BILLS INTO LAW WEDNESDAY (APRIL 12.) THE BILLS WERE PASSED BY THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA DURING ITS RECENT SESSION IN PALAU. THE THREE MOST SIGNIFICANT MEASURES TO BECOME LAW

AND VILLAGE HOMESTEADING.

ALL THREE OF THESE MEASURES HAD PREVIOUSLY BEEN VETOED BY THE HICOM, ALTHOUGH IN SUBSTANTIALLY DIFFERENT FORMS. THE BILLS WERE ALL RE-CONSIDERED AND RE-WRITTEN BY THE CONGRESS TO TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE PREVIOUS OBJECTIONS OF THE ADMINISTRATION.

SENATE VICE-PRESIDENT OLYMPIC BORJA OF THE MARIANAS, WHO WITNESSED THE SIGNING OF THESE BILLS IN THE HICOM'S OFFICE ALONG WITH LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL MAMORU NAKAMURA, WAS CLEARLY PLEASED THAT THEY HAD BECOME LAW. PALAU APRIL 12, (MNS)---THE PALAU DISTRICT LEGISLATURE, CURRENTLY MEETING IN KOROR, HAS RECEIVED A THIRD RESOLUTION FOR CONSIDERATION CONCERNING THE FUTURE POLITICAL STATUS ISSUE AS THE STATUS TALKS CONTINUE IN PALAU.

THE RESOLUTION, INTRODUCED AT THE SESSION TUESDAY (APRIL 11), WAS OFFERED BY LEGISLATOR TADAO NGOTEL, WHO HAS ALREADY INTRODUCED A PREVIOUS RESOLUTION WHICH HAS BEEN OF INTEREST TO THE STATUS NEGOTIATORS. THAT PREVIOUS RESOLUTION WOULD HAVE THE LEGISLATURE OPPOSE ANY USE OF LAND FOR MILITARY PURPOSES OR THE STATIONING OF ANY MILITARY PERSONNEL IN PALAU DISTRICT AND HAVE THE AREA DECLARED A SO-CALLED NEUTRAL ZONE.

THE NEW RESOLUTION IS TITLED AS FOLLOWS: "A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY URGING THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON FUTURE STATUS TO BREAK OFF THE FOURTH ROUND OF NEGOTIATIONS NOW BEING HELD IN PALAU DISTRICT IF IN ITS OPINION THE U.S. IS NOT RESPONDING FAVORABLY TO THE MICRONESIAN OFFER OF FREE ASSOCIATION."

THE BODY OF THE RESOLUTION STATES ESSENTIALLY THAT LEGISLATOR NGOTEL DOES NOT WANT PALAU DISTRICT TO BE REMEMBERED AS THE DISTRICT WHERE MICRONESIA WAS COMPELLED TO ENTER INTO AN ASSOCIATION WITH THE UNITED STATES BY WHICH MICRONESIANS WOULD LOSE CONTROL OVER THEIR LIVELIHOOD AND DESTINY.
